

TOM WALKER SHARES NEW SONG "ALL THAT MATTERS" TODAY

KICKS OFF U.S. TOUR IN JULY



(May 15, 2019 – Los Angeles, CA) – Chart-topping troubadour Tom Walker uncovers a brand new track entitled "All That Matters" today. Get it HERE!

The song arrives hot on the heels of his latest full-length, *What A Time To Be Alive*, which bowed at #1 in the UK and James Corden enthusiastically christened as "brilliant." A standout from the project, "Just You & I" is currently raising up the airplay charts in the U.S., while also heating up at Hot AC radio and impacting Top 40 radio two weeks ago. The track also continues to stay in the Top 5 on the UK Airplay Chart.

Penned for his grandmother Sadie, "All That Matters" showcases his instantly identifiable vulnerability. Strumming a solo acoustic guitar between glistening piano, he reaffirms an undeniable and universal message, "Love is all that matters in the end. Can't spend your money when you're dead. Can't live this life again...At least we got love."

About the song, **Walker** commented, "Last year, me and my Gran shared a bottle of wine and spent an evening chatting and catching up. No telly, no music, no distractions, it was just Reminiscing about all the good times—and the bad. A couple of weeks later, I sat down, and we wrote this based on the wealth of wisdom, knowledge and all the stories my Gran told me about her life. It's one of the most honest songs I've ever written. I still struggle not to shed a tear when singing the second verse. This one's for my Gran. It's called, *'All That Matters'*."

The song offers hardcore fans and supporters a gracious "thank you" following the runaway sustained success of **What A Time To Be Alive**.

Next up, **Walker** returns to U.S. soil for a much-anticipated nine-date North American tour this summer. It begins Wednesday July 24 at Lincoln Hall in Chicago, IL, visits major markets on the East Coast, and closes out Tuesday August 5 at Music Hall of Williamsburg in Brooklyn, NY.

ABOUT TOM WALKER

Tom Walker brings a whole lot of shine, soul, and spirit to popular music and culture. In doing so, the Scotland-born and Manchester-raised singer and songwriter quietly vaulted towards international stardom during 2018. His breakout single **"Leave A Light On"** achieved global sales of 2.5 million, captured #1 on iTunes in 20 countries, and went platinum in nine territories including the UK, Netherlands, France, Germany and Australia and gold in four countries. Becoming the **"6th most Shazam'ed track in the world,"** it also generated upwards of 390 million cumulative streams and 110 million video views within six months. As the song took off, he hit the stage for television performances on both sides of the pond, appearing on UK *X Factor* twice and on *The Today Show* stateside. A true live phenomenon, he entertained over 800,000 fans in 2018 between headline gigs and a high-profile tour alongside The Script. Topping off the year, he garnered the ASCAP Vanguard Award, placing him in good company with previous honorees such as Dua Lipa and Calvin Harris, to name a few. Additionally, he received a coveted BRIT Award in the category of "British Breakthrough Artist."

Still, everything merely set the stage for his full-length debut, *What A Time To Be Alive*, which arrived March 1, 2019 via **Epic Records**. He preceded the release with an updated version of his fan favorite "**Just You And I**," which previously racked up over 100 million streams. On the verge of a massive new year, **Walker** continues to deliver anthems with honesty and heart like only he can.
