RETURNS TO THE STATES FOR NORTH AMERICAN TOUR IN JULY

(May 31, 2019 – Los Angeles, CA) – Dominating charts around the world and receiving widespread acclaim, Tom Walker reveals his music video for "Now You're Gone" featuring Zara Larsson today.

The cinematic visual ties a gripping narrative to the tune. In the clip, *The Vampire Diaries* star **Michael Malarkey** and actress **Veronica Oliver** engage in an emotionally charged torrential romance marred by addiction, violence, and various ups and downs against a backdrop of decaying Rust Belt Americana. This turbulence remains soundtracked by the single's gliding production and powerhouse vocal performances from both **Walker** and multiplatinum superstar **Zara Larsson**. The lyrics prove equally compelling and catchy.

Written by Walker, along with UK songwriting powerhouse Steve Mac (Leave A Light On) and Chelcee Grimes, "Now You're Gone" stands out as the latest single from the chart-topping troubadour's latest full-length, What A Time To Be Alive, which bowed at #1 in the UK and James Corden enthusiastically christened as "brilliant." A standout from the project, "Just You & I" has been certified platinum in the UK, holding in the UK Top 10 singles chart for 11 consecutive weeks. The track also continues to stay in the Top 5 on the UK Airplay Chart, where it peaked at #1. In the U.S., it is currently raising up the airplay charts, while also heating up at Hot AC radio and Top 40 radio.

He recently launched a sold out tour across the UK and will be performing at Glastonbury on both June 27 and June 30.

Next up, **Walker** returns to U.S. soil for a much-anticipated nine-date North American tour this summer. It begins Wednesday July 24 at Lincoln Hall in Chicago, IL, visits major markets on the East Coast, and closes out Tuesday August 5 at Music Hall of Williamsburg in Brooklyn, NY. The tour also includes a stop in Montreal, Canada for Osheaga Festival on August 2.

The BRIT Award-winning UK singer, songwriter, and artist continues to make waves on both sides of the pond. <u>Billboard</u> recently profiled him with an in-depth feature and praised **What A Time To Be Alive** as a "14-song collection of heartfelt lyrics, striking guitar and striking vocals." He also delivered a standout performance of the breakout single "Just You & I" on The Late Late Show with James Corden. In case you missed it, watch it <u>HERE</u>. After its debut on March 1, **What A Time To Be Alive** spent 11 consecutive weeks on the UK Top 10 album chart. Meanwhile, the album put up impressive numbers across the board. "Leave A Light On" has tallied 490 million-plus cumulative streams and 132 million views thus far and soared to #1 in 20 countries. The follow-up "Just You And I" surpassed 230 million streams. Topping off the year, he garnered the ASCAP Vanguard Award, placing him in good company with previous honorees such as Dua Lipa and Calvin Harris, to name a few. Walker also received his first-ever honor at the prestigious 2019 BRIT Awards—cementing him among an elite club of honorees including Ed Sheeran, Sam Smith, Dua Lipa, and more. Don't miss him live!
